1. All the Candidates of PGRRCDE shall produce their registration card for inspection along with the hall ticket to the invigilator / any authority checking in the examination hall, as and when they asked.
2. a) Candidates can download the Hall Tickets from our Website: www.oucde.net, 3 days before the commencement of examinations.
b) The Candidates shall produce a proof of having paid the examination fee / submission of examination form etc., when they approach the Centre for duplicate hall tickets.
3. Whenever there is a change in the syllabus, the old batch of students have to appear according to the new syllabus. Whenever they appear they have to ascertain the papers they have to appear and fill in the form. The Centre will not be responsible if they fail to the rules and regulations in force.
