- 8. The exam Centre once allotted will not be changed under any circumstances. Exam Centres for (Previous & Final) year are located at CHARMINAR, KUKATPALLY, L.B. NAGAR, SECUNDERABAD (HYDERABAD), MAHABUBNAGAR, MEDAK, NALGONDA, NIZAMABAD, SURYAPET, KAMAREDDY, SIDDIPET, TANDUR, SANGAREDDY and VIKARABAD only.

#### 9. Candidates will not be allowed to enter the examination hall after (10) ten minutes of the commencement of examination.

- 10. Candidates are not allowed to carry printed material / manuscript or any other objectionable material inside the examination hall.
- 11. Programmable Calculators and Cell Phones are strictly prohibited in the Examination Hall.
- 12. Normally, the dates of examinations printed in the time table will not be changed. However, changes in the time table, if any, will be published in Daily News Papers Namaste Telangana, Eenadu and Deccan Chronicle.
